6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the bounty on wolves."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.05.250(8) is amended to read:

9 (8) investigating and determining the extent and effect of
10 predation and competition among fish and game in the state, exercising
11 control measures considered necessary to the resources of the state
12 and, with the exception of AS 16.35.055, designating game management
13 units or parts of game management units in which bounties for predatory
14 animals shall be paid;

15 * Sec. 2. AS 16.35.050 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 16.35.050. BOUNTY DECLARED. Upon every wolverine, wild
17 lobo or timber wolf and every wild coyote or prairie wolf, legally
18 taken within the state, there is a bounty of \$15 for each wolverine,
19 \$100 [\$50] for each wolf and \$30 for each coyote.

20 * Sec. 3. AS 16.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

21 Sec. 16.35.055. TAKING OF WOLVES. There is no game management
22 unit or season closed to the taking of wolves for the purposes of
23 sec. 50 of this chapter.
