6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to work and rehabilitation furloughs." *Prisoners*

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 33.30 is amended by adding a new section to read: *149W*

9 Sec. 33.30.260. REHABILITATION FURLOUGHS. The commissioner may
10 authorize a prisoner to participate in educational, training, medical,
11 psychiatric, or other rehabilitation programs approved by the commis-
12 sioner. When the prisoner is not participating in a rehabilitation
13 program, he shall be confined in the jail unless the commissioner
14 directs otherwise. If the prisoner violates the conditions established
15 for his conduct or custody, the commissioner may order the balance of
16 the prisoner's sentence to be spent in actual confinement. The wilful
17 failure of a prisoner to return to the place of confinement not later
18 than the expiration of any period during which he is authorized to be
19 away from the place of confinement under this section, is an escape
20 from the place of confinement and is punishable under the laws relating
21 to escape.
