6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to notice of proposed regulations
7 by administrative agencies; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.62.200 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.62.200. CONTENTS OF NOTICE. (a) The notice of proposed
12 adoption, amendment, or repeal of a regulation shall include

13 (1) a statement of the time, place, and nature of proceedings
14 for adoption, amendment, or repeal of the regulation;

15 (2) reference to the authority under which the regulation
16 is proposed and a reference to the particular code section or other
17 provisions of law which are being implemented, interpreted, or made
18 specific;

19 (3) [EITHER THE EXPRESS TERMS OR] an informative summary
20 of the proposed subject of agency action;

21 (4) other matters prescribed by a statute applicable to
22 the specific agency or to the specific regulation or class of regula-
23 tions.

24 (b) A regulation which is adopted, amended or repealed may vary
25 in content from the summary specified in (a)(3) of this section if the
26 subject matter of the regulation remains the same and the original
27 notice was written so as to assure that members of the public are
28 reasonably notified of the proposed subject of agency action in
29 order for them to determine whether their interests could be affected

1 by agency action on that subject.

2 * Sec. 2. The proposed regulations of the Department of Public Safety
3 (13 AAC 04.280, 13 AAC 04.285, 13 AAC 04.290, 13 AAC 04.295, and 13 AAC
4 04.300) shall not be effective until April 1, 1971.

5 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
6 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
