For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the authority of certain classes
7 of cities and organized boroughs with respect to
8 urban renewal."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Sec. 18.55.720. AUTHORITY MAY DELEGATE FUNCTIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES

AND PUBLIC BODIES. (a) The authority may delegate to a municipality
13 or other public body any of its powers or functions with respect to
14 the planning or undertaking of an urban renewal project in the area
15 in which the municipality or public body is authorized to act, and
16 the municipality or public body may carry out or perform these powers
17 and functions for the authority.

(b) Upon the adoption of an ordinance by the governing body of a
19 first class city or first class borough requesting the delegation to
20 the municipality of authority powers or functions designated in (a) of
21 this section, the authority shall delegate the powers or functions
22 requested and may revoke the powers or functions delegated only upon
23 adoption of an ordinance by the governing body requesting revocation.

(c) As used in this section "first class city" means a general law
25 first class city or a first class city which has adopted a home rule
26 charter, and "first class organized borough" means a general law first
27 class borough or a first class borough which has adopted a home rule
28 charter.
