6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of judicial, execu-
7 tive, and state employees; per diem and compensation
8 of legislators; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The chief justice and each associate justice shall receive
12 \$36,000 annually as compensation [THE CHIEF JUSTICE SHALL RECEIVE
13 \$30,000 ANNUALLY, AND EACH ASSOCIATE JUSTICE SHALL RECEIVE \$28,000
14 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION]. The compensation is payable monthly in
15 12 equal installments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an
16 associate justice shall not be diminished during his term of office,
17 unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

19 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$33,000 [\$26,500]
20 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
21 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term

Sec. 39.20.030. ANNUAL SALARY OF SECRETARY OF STATE. The annual salary of the secretary of state is \$36,000 [\$28,500]. The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 39.20.080. SALARY OF EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT HEAD AND DEPUTY.

(a) The annual salary of the head of each principal executive department of the state upon appointment and confirmation is \$33,000 [\$27,500]. This salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

(b) The monthly salary of the deputy head of each principal executive department of the state, upon his appointment is not less than Step A, Range 28, nor shall it exceed Step F [STEP C], Range 28, of Salary Schedule I, set out in AS 39.27.010(1), during the term of his appointment.

23 for each member of the legislature is \$9,000[\$6,000] to be paid in
24 approximately equal monthly payments. The president of the senate and
25 speaker of the house of representatives are each entitled to an addi-
26 tional \$500 a year during tenure of office.

28 Sec. 24.15.030. ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCES. In addition, each member
29 of ~~the~~ legislature is entitled to an annual allowance of \$4,000 [\$1,000]

1 for postage, stationery, stenographic services and other expenses.

2 * Sec. 11. It is the intent of the legislature that all permanent
3 employees of the legislative branch of the government shall receive pay
4 increments as comparable as possible to those provided the classified em-
5 ployees in sec. 7 of this Act.

6 * Sec. 12. This Act takes effect on July 16, 1970.
