9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Sec. 23.15.520. DEFINITIONS. In secs. 330 - 520 of this chapter

12 (1) "employment agency" or "agency" means a person engaged  
13 in the business of furnishing employment or help, or giving information  
14 as to where employment or help may be obtained, or furnishing informa-  
15 tion regarding employment, or displaying an employment sign or  
16 bulletin, or, through the medium of a card, circular or pamphlet, or  
17 otherwise offering to obtain employment or help, or a person who  
18 offers employment information through communication media, including,  
19 but not limited to, radio, television, newspapers;

20 (2) "fee" means money or other valuable consideration  
21 received by a person, paid or promised to be paid for services given  
22 or to be given by a person conducting an employment agency;

23 (3) "registration fee" means a charge made or attempted to  
24 be made for registering or listing an applicant for employment, or  
25 for the furnishing of employment information as set forth in this  
26 section.

27 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approv-  
28 al or on the day it becomes law without approval.
