5 Requesting a feasibility study of the  
6 construction of a home for aged  
7 natives in Northwestern Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, the aged residents of the communities of Northwestern Alaska  
10 have expressed a strong desire for a home for their exclusive use and enjoy-  
11 ment; and

12 WHEREAS, the many substandard housing conditions which exist in this  
13 area work a particular hardship on the senior citizens of the native  
14 community; and

15 WHEREAS, it is but fitting that one approaching the eventide of life  
16 be surrounded by a comfortable and pleasant environment; and

17 WHEREAS, the people of Alaska are justly proud of the aged natives'  
18 contribution to the historical and economic development of the state;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
20 the Department of Health and Welfare to conduct a feasibility study con-  
21 cerning the construction of a home for the aged natives in Northwestern  
22 Alaska, including costs and alternative sites, and to report its findings  
23 to the Sixth State Legislature at the convening of the second session;  
24 and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Health and Welfare be  
26 encouraged to enlist the aid and cooperation of the Bureau of Indian Affairs  
27 in this study.
