5 Relating to assistance of the Legisla-
6 ture at the first annual Girls'
7 State.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the first annual Girls' State program will be held on the campus
10 and facilities of the University of Alaska, at Fairbanks, Alaska, beginning
11 on June 8, 1969; and

12 WHEREAS at Girls' State the delegates learn the duties of the various
13 offices connected with city, borough, and state government; and

14 WHEREAS part of the program connected with state government is the
15 election of a legislature, and the introduction and debate upon bills in
16 accordance with regular legislative procedure; and

17 WHEREAS the legislature could be of valuable aid to the operation of the
18 first annual Girls' State program, by having the Legislative Affairs Agency
19 prepare materials necessary for a better understanding of the legislative
20 process and by having designated legislators and Agency staff members in
21 attendance at Girls' State to aid in any way possible with the legislative
22 program;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature direct the Legislative Council to
24 authorize the Legislative Affairs Agency to assist in the preparation of
25 legislative materials and, on request of the Girls' State chairmen, to have
26 legislators designated by the presiding officer of each house and two Agency
27 staff members attend the first annual Girls' State to aid the delegates in
28 the legislative program.
