2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 24

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE -- FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the creation of the
6 Serpentine Hot Springs State Park
7 and the construction of an access road
8 to it.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS the Serpentine Hot Springs, located on public domain near Nome,
11 Alaska, are among the natural wonders of the state; and

12 WHEREAS these hot springs will constitute an important attraction to
13 residents of the state and tourists from outside the state; and

14 WHEREAS these hot springs and the surrounding areas should be preserved
15 from private or commercial exploitation if maximum benefit is to be derived
16 from them; and

17 WHEREAS there is presently no access road to Serpentine Hot Springs;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
19 the Department of Natural Resources to select at the earliest possible time,
20 the tract of land on which the Serpentine Hot Springs are located, and to
21 classify as a park the springs and as much surrounding land as may be
22 necessary to secure their full use and enjoyment to the people of the state;
23 and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that after the land for the park has been selected,
25 the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the Department of Highways
26 to construct an access road from Taylor to Serpentine Springs.
