BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the sound agricultural economy of Alaska now and in the future

9

depends to a great extent on the fertility of its soil; and

WHEREAS the massive Katmai eruption of 1912 destroyed most of the

11

valuable topsoil on Kodiak Island; and

12

WHEREAS a supply of lime from Homer can do much to alleviate this con-

13

dition and restore critical nutrients to the land for agricultural purposes,

14

thereby greatly benefiting the people of Kodiak Island;

15

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct

16

the Department of Public Works, in conformity with Coast Guard safety regula-

17

tions, to allow free transportation of lime on its ferry from Homer to

18

Kodiak.
