HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 28  
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Requesting the governor to declare the  
month of October, "Country Music  
Month".

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS country music, one of the few forms of music truly indigenous  
to the United States, is among the most popular music in the country today;  
and

WHEREAS much Alaska folklore has been incorporated and popularized in  
country music; and

WHEREAS many Alaskans appreciate and enjoy country music, in fact no  
less a personage than the governor has been extolled by music lovers across  
the state for his country music singing abilities; and

WHEREAS the country music industry provides economic benefits to the  
State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS since the annual Country Music Association awards are presented  
during the month of October, it would be fitting to recognize and honor  
country music during that month;

BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is requested to declare the month of  
October, "Country Music Month".
