5 Requesting the Governor to declare the  
6 month of October, 1969, "Country Music  
7 Month."

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS country music, one of the few forms of music truly indigenous  
10 to the United States, is among the most popular music in the country today;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS much Alaska folklore has been incorporated and popularized in  
13 country music; and

14 WHEREAS many Alaskans appreciate and enjoy country music, in fact no  
15 less a personage than the Governor has been extolled by music lovers across  
16 the state for his country music singing abilities; and

17 WHEREAS the country music industry provides economic benefits to the  
18 State of Alaska; and

19 WHEREAS since the annual Country Music Association awards are presented  
20 during the month of October, it would be fitting to recognize and honor  
21 country music during that month;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to declare the month of  
23 October, 1969, "Country Music Month."
