5 Relating to the leases from the  
6 Alaska State Housing Authority.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the legislature by Ch. 99, SLA 1965 provided for the construc-  
9 tion and acquisition by the Alaska State Housing Authority of public build-  
10 ings for lease to the state; and

11 WHEREAS the leasing program has been entered into under the Act; and

12 WHEREAS AS 37.05.280 requires that any additional lease executed after  
13 January 1, 1966 which provides for payment in excess of \$12,000 annually be  
14 approved by the legislature; and

15 WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to enter into additional  
16 leases set out in this Resolution;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that use of the space to be provided by lease of the  
18 following premises by the State of Alaska from the Alaska State Housing  
19 Authority and the lease of the premises from the Alaska State Housing  
20 Authority providing for payments in excess of \$12,000 annually is approved:

21 LEASED FACILITY

22 (1) Headquarters Building, Department of Fish and Game, Sand Point  
23 Village, Popoff Island, Alaska;

24 (2) Kalsin Bay Highway Maintenance Shop, Department of Highways;

25 (3) Cordova Highway Maintenance Shop, Department of Highways;

26 (4) Trims Highway Maintenance Shop, Department of Highways;

27 (5) Nome District Highway Office, Department of Highways;

28 (6) Alaska State Court Building, Anchorage;

29 (7) Alcantra Youth Camp.
