3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the construction of air-
6 fields at Marshall and Sheldon Point.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Division of Aviation of the Department of Public Works has
9 scheduled airport construction for the villages of Marshall and Sheldon Point
10 for its 1975 and 1976 fiscal years; and

11 WHEREAS these two large villages are without adequate access during
12 several months in the spring and fall of each year and are serviced during
13 the remaining parts of the year by float and ski planes; and

14 WHEREAS, because of the load limitations on float and ski planes, the
15 people of Marshall and Sheldon Point are denied access to as large a variety
16 of necessary goods and supplies as other villages similarly situated; and

17 WHEREAS mail service to these villages is totally disrupted during
18 several months a year and it is very irregular during the rest of the year
19 because of the present lack of airstrips; and

20 WHEREAS the needs of the residents of Marshall and Sheldon Point are
21 immediate;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth State Legislature, that the Governor is
23 respectfully requested to direct the Commissioner of Public Works to transfer
24 the projected construction of airstrips at Marshall and Sheldon Point from
25 the 1975 and 1976 fiscal years construction programs to the 1970 fiscal year
26 construction program.
