8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears, the Southeast Alaska champions,
10 have played the Lathrop High School Malemutes for the state basketball
11 championship; and

12 WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears defeated the Lathrop High School
13 Malemutes this week in a three-game competition, thus winning the 1969 state
14 basketball crown; and

15 WHEREAS the Juneau-Douglas Crimson Bears, by defeating the Malemutes in
16 three straight games, climaxed one of their most impressive seasons in their
17 history;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature extends to the Juneau-
19 Douglas Crimson Bears and the Lathrop High School Malemutes its commendation
20 on the winning of their regional titles and salutes both teams for the
21 climactic state competition of this past week; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature expresses its
23 heartiest congratulations to each and every member of the Juneau-Douglas
24 Crimson Bears and to their coach Clair Markey on their successful pursuit of
25 the 1969 state basketball crown.
