7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS winter sporting events are assuming increasing importance in
9 the lives of all Alaskans; and

10 WHEREAS the terrain and climate in Alaska offers some of the best
11 opportunity for winter sports of any of the states in the United States; and

12 WHEREAS Alpine and Nordic skiing are nationally popular forms of recre-
13 ation and competition; and

14 WHEREAS Alaska skiers have been drawing favorable attention to Alaska
15 by their high competitive standings in Alpine and Nordic ski competition; and

16 WHEREAS nationally sanctioned ski events are of great public relations
17 value to the State of Alaska and its economic growth and development;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature expresses its most
19 sincere thanks to the Alaska Division of the United States Ski Association
20 for having Alyeska designated as the site for the 1969 Junior National Ski
21 Races, March 17 - 23, 1969; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature wishes the Alaska
23 Division of the United States Ski Association every success in conducting
24 this highly publicized national event.
