2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 43

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the construction of a road
6 between St. Marys and Mountain Village.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the towns of St. Marys and Mountain Village are in great need
9 of a connecting road to facilitate communication, transportation and com-
10 merce, generally, between the towns; and

11 WHEREAS the need for a road has been obvious for a number of years and
12 one was requested five years ago without result; and

13 WHEREAS there are over 1,000 people residing in the two towns, with
14 numerous others living in the vicinity, who would benefit from the road; and

15 WHEREAS a hospital is being built next year which will be used by the
16 residents of both St. Marys and Mountain Village; and

17 WHEREAS the Alaska Village Electric Co-op is presently connecting the
18 two towns with electrical poles and lines; and

19 WHEREAS, to further the mutual development of St. Marys and Mountain
20 Village, a road between them is a necessity which requires immediate action;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct
22 the Department of Highways to schedule construction of a road between St.
23 Marys and Mountain Village in its construction program and budget for the
24 1970 fiscal year.
