5 Relating to the study of commercial
6 fishing gear license limitation by the
7 Institute for Social, Economic and
8 Governmental Research.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS HB 240 appropriates \$100,000 to the University of Alaska, Insti-
11 tute for Social, Economic and Government Research, for the purpose of making
12 a study of commercial fishing gear license limitation in order to provide
13 the legislature with information needed to devise a limited entry system
14 for fisheries;

15 BE IT RESOLVED that the study shall include (1) an analysis of the
16 need to protect marine resources from excessive exploitation, definition and
17 evaluation of alternative methods of gear limitation, evaluation of the
18 economic and social implications of the alternatives and appraisal of their
19 legality under the U.S. Constitution, the state constitution, and federal
20 law, and (2) a report prepared by the Institute to be submitted to the
21 Legislative Council no later than January 15, 1970, covering the analyses,
22 findings and conclusions of the study; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Fish and Game is requested to
24 provide any appropriate assistance needed to carry out the study, and the
25 Institute shall maintain appropriate liaison with the Department, state and
26 federal agencies, and with others concerned with effective utilization of
27 the state's fisheries resources.
