5 Relating to the paving of an access  
6 road from the Richardson Highway to  
7 the Delta Junction School.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS there is currently a contract out to bid for paving a portion  
10 of the Richardson Highway at Delta Junction; and

11 WHEREAS a state grade and high school is located seven-tenths of a mile  
12 from the proposed paving job; and

13 WHEREAS the safety, comfort, and well-being of our school children is  
14 of prime importance and priority when state capital improvements are con-  
15 sidered; and

16 WHEREAS the cost of the additional paving would be minimal, since the  
17 necessary construction material and machines are in the area and are im-  
18 mediately available;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct  
20 the Department of Highways to negotiate with whomever is awarded the contract  
21 so that the portion of the road from the Richardson Highway to the Delta  
22 Junction School will be paved and an adequate sidewalk will be included in  
23 the job.
