3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the establishment of a
6 law school as part of the University
7 of Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS law is the foundation of democracy; and

10 WHEREAS the situation created by Alaska's increasing population and
11 developing economy requires that more of the state's citizens possess a
12 legal education; and

13 WHEREAS a law school within the state would serve this need and would
14 help democratize the legal profession by making a legal education available
15 to those who can not afford to go outside the state to attend law school;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature requests the Board of Regents of
17 the University of Alaska to establish the position of, and the President of
18 the University to appoint, a dean of the law school, whose duties during
19 the first year will consist of planning the school -- dealing with such
20 matters as faculty, curriculum, a law library, and the physical plant -- and
21 reporting these plans and estimates of cost to the First Session of the
22 Seventh Legislature; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intent of the legislature that during
24 the planning stages of the law school the dean be furnished office space and
25 a secretary and the full cooperation as needed of all state agencies in
26 making these plans.
