2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 33

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the Seventh State Legis-
6 lature - First Session.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the most populous area of the state is the Southcentral Region;
9 and

10 WHEREAS it is now virtually impossible for citizens of the state, other
11 than those who reside in Juneau, to ever meet with their elected representa-
12 tives during a legislative session or to observe these officials in their
13 everyday role as the policy makers for the people of Alaska; and

14 WHEREAS Anchorage is the city in Alaska most centrally located and is
15 accessible by all modes of transportation; and

16 WHEREAS it would be of tremendous benefit to the legislature to have,
17 on a day to day basis, the opinions and advice of the greatest number of
18 citizens of the state possible; and

19 WHEREAS, if the legislature were to meet in Anchorage, persons from
20 all walks of life and from diverse areas of the state would have the oppor-
21 tunity to observe "government in action" and thereby gain invaluable insight
22 and knowledge concerning the political process;

23 BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislature of the State of Alaska that the
24 Seventh Legislature - First Session convene in Anchorage on January 11, 1971
25 and remain in session in Anchorage until such time as the Seventh Legisla-
26 ture - First Session is adjourned.
