BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the second greatest love is man's love of that vanishing, noble

9

beast, the wolf; and

10

WHEREAS Alaska has an overabundance of these lovable, gentle animals

11

in some areas of the state; and

WHEREAS the management and control of its wolf population by the

13

State of Alaska has come under attack both from within and without the

14

state; and

15

WHEREAS the state has long used wolf bounties as a game management

16

tool for predator control; and

17

WHEREAS this practice has been widely deplored by many citizens and

18

organizations of other states where apparent shortages of wolves exist; and

19

WHEREAS it is within the jurisdiction of the Department of Fish and

20

Game to designate wolf bounty areas within the state;

21

BE IT RESOLVED by the Sixth State Legislature that the Governor is

22

respectfully requested to direct the Department of Fish and Game to notify

23

the Governors of all other states whenever a wolf bounty area is designated,

24

that each state may send qualified personnel to Alaska to capture and

25

transport as many live wolves as are desired for developing wolf popula-

26

tions in their own state.
