Proposing that more adequate fire-

fighting equipment be available and

7

manned at major airports in the state.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS adequate firefighting equipment at most of the major airports

10

in the state is essential to the safety and well-being of the flying public;

11

and

WHEREAS firefighting personnel at those airports should be adequately

13

prepared to respond in the precious first few minutes of an emergency; and

14

WHEREAS statistics on airline fires show unequivocally that the oppor-

15

tunity to control an aircraft fire exists only during those first few

16

minutes before reaching highly explosive fuel supplies;

17

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct

18

the Department of Public Works and the Department of Public Safety to con-

19

duct a survey of firefighting equipment and personnel at all major airports

20

in the state so that the safety and well-being of the flying public are

21

fully assured; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the survey be submitted to the Seventh Legislature,

First Session.
