7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Alaskans have served with distinction in this nation's declared
9 and undeclared wars, many having made the ultimate sacrifice; and

10 WHEREAS yet another son -- Frederick M. Simeonoff, born in Kodiak 22
11 years ago and graduated from the Sheldon Jackson High School in Sitka --
12 heeded his country's call; and

13 WHEREAS this young Alaskan volunteered for military training schools
14 culminating in graduation with honors from the helicopter pilot program at
15 Fort Rucker, Alabama; and

16 WHEREAS seven short weeks following his arrival in Vietnam, Warrant
17 Officer Frederick M. Simeonoff was killed in action when an army helicopter
18 he was co-piloting crashed in a river; and

19 WHEREAS he has returned from the Vietnam War for burial, April 29,
20 1970, on Kodiak;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska State Legislature, in recognition
22 of the sacrifice of Warrant Officer Frederick M. Simeonoff, posthumously
23 commends him for his service and extends to his family its deepest sympathy.
