4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to an air route between
6 Fairbanks, Juneau, Minneapolis-St.
7 Paul, and Chicago.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS air transportation has always been vital to the people and
10 economy of Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS tourist and business travel between Alaska and the other states
12 is increasing at a tremendous rate; and

13 WHEREAS at present there is a severely limited number of air routes be-
14 tween Alaska and the other states; and

15 WHEREAS by Presidential Proclamation there was established the Discover
16 America Program to promote travel within the United States;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Civil Aeronautics Board is urged to grant an
18 exemption or schedule an expeditious hearing on Wien Air Alaska's proposed
19 route between Fairbanks, Juneau, Minneapolis-St. Paul, and Chicago at the
20 earliest date possible in order that the people in these areas will be pro-
21 vided a needed service.
