2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 21

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the naming of the  
6 proposed COMSAT ground station  
7 near Talkeetna, Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS a new satellite communications ground station (Comsat) is to be  
10 constructed near Talkeetna and the proposed location site is presently  
11 unnamed; and

12 WHEREAS the construction of the site is awaiting authorization by the  
13 Federal Communications Commission; and

14 WHEREAS the late Senator E. L. "Bob" Bartlett was for many years an  
15 eloquent advocate of improved communications for the State of Alaska; and

16 WHEREAS the Communications Satellite Corporation has indicated its  
17 willingness to cooperate in naming the earth station in honor of the late  
18 Senator E. L. "Bob" Bartlett;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature urges the Federal  
20 Communications Commission to approve Comsat's application for construction  
21 of the ground station; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED that the location site be named "Bartlett."
