2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 23

5 Proposing an amendment to Article III  
6 of the Constitution of the State of  
7 Alaska relating to the election of  
8 district attorneys.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. Article III, Constitution of the State of Alaska, is amended  
11 by adding a new section to read:

12 SECTION 28. District attorneys shall be elected for four-year  
13 terms in each of the four judicial districts of the State. A district  
14 attorney shall be at least twenty-six years of age and a qualified  
15 voter of the State. He shall be licensed to practice law in the State  
16 and shall have been a resident of Alaska at least two years immediately  
17 preceding his filing for office.

19 FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before the  
20 voters of the State at the next statewide election in conformity with Section  
21 1, Article XIII, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election laws  
22 of the state.
