3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing that the Constitution of the  
6 State of Alaska be amended to require  
7 borough assemblymen representing a  
8 first class city, or other class of  
9 city designated by law, to be elected  
10 by city voters rather than being ap-  
11 pointed by and from the city council.

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 \* Section 1. Section 4, Article X, Constitution of the State of Alaska  
14 is amended to read:

15 SECTION 4. ASSEMBLY. The governing body of the organized borough  
16 shall be the assembly, and its composition shall be established by law  
17 or charter. Each city of the first class, and each city of any other  
18 class designated by law, shall be represented on the assembly by one or  
19 more assemblymen elected from and by the qualified voters of the city  
20 [MEMBERS OF ITS COUNCIL]. The other members of the assembly shall be  
21 elected from and by the qualified voters resident outside such cities.

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that this proposed amendment be placed before the  
24 voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity with Sec-  
25 tion 1, Article XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska and the  
26 State Election Code.
