2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 39

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to a flight between Nome and
6 Provideniya, Siberia.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Eskimos on the northwest coast of Alaska are closely related
9 to the Eskimos on the Siberian coast, but contact between them is entirely
10 cut off; and

11 WHEREAS communication often breaks down the barriers of ignorance and
12 fear that are frequently the cause of enmity between nations; and

13 WHEREAS a regular flight between the northwestern coast of Alaska and
14 the coast of Siberia would not only bring these related Eskimos together but
15 would in general provide the opportunity for greater communication between
16 the two nations; and

17 WHEREAS such a flight would increase tourism in Alaska and thus benefit
18 the economy greatly;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature urges the Civil Aero-
20 nautics Board to approve an Alaska Airlines flight between Nome, Alaska, and
21 Provideniya, Siberia.

24 Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics Board; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens

26 W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
