5 Relating to the location of the head-
6 quarters of the Alaska Native Industrial
7 Co-operative Association.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the location of the headquarters of the Alaska Native In-
10 dustrial Co-operative Association (ANICA) in Seattle, Washington, is working
11 undue hardship on the people it was intended to serve due to the expense of
12 shipping costs; and

13 WHEREAS there are presently wholesale outlets in Anchorage and Fairbanks
14 capable of handling ANICA's purchasing needs thus eliminating the present
15 shipping costs from Seattle to Alaska; and

16 WHEREAS the headquarters of ANICA in Seattle makes the organization
17 unresponsive to the immediate problems of the people it was intended to
18 serve;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature urges the Bureau of Indian Affairs
20 to conduct an informal study of the situation and recommend location of the
21 headquarters of ANICA in an area which would be closer to the people this
22 organization was intended to serve.

24 Nixon, President of the United States; the Honorable Walter J. Hickel,
25 Secretary of the Interior; the Honorable Charles A. Richmond, Area Director,
26 Bureau of Indian Affairs; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens, the Honorable
27 Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators and the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S.
28 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
