2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 44

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the rehabilitation of the
6 main seaside road between the Air Force
7 base at Unalakleet and the village.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS at Unalakleet the main seaside road leading to the Air Force
10 base is on an extremely low level, with high tides causing the strip to
11 erode rapidly; and

12 WHEREAS this constant erosion has created an extremely hazardous con-
13 dition making the only access to safety impossible to cross; and

14 WHEREAS during the flood of 1966 boats had to be utilized three miles
15 from the village, making the rescue operation highly dangerous in view of the
16 drifting debris, broken ice, and terrific pressure of the current; and

17 WHEREAS there is no reason to suppose that such a flood will not occur
18 in the future;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Legislature of the State of Alaska
20 respectfully requests the Corps of Engineers, United States Army to rehabili-
21 tate and rebuild the access road at Unalakleet to its former seaside road
22 level.
