2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 46

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the construction of a four-  
6 year high school with boarding facili-  
7 ties and a gymnasium at Unalakleet.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS Unalakleet and the surrounding areas are in dire need of a full-  
10 fledged four-year high school, since the nearly 4,000 residents of the total  
11 area have only a junior high school to serve their pressing educational needs,  
12 and

13 WHEREAS due to this deplorable situation, the students of the junior  
14 high must travel great distances elsewhere to finish their schooling, at a  
15 great cost to the government; and

16 WHEREAS even such a basic facility as a gymnasium is nonexistent at  
17 Unalakleet, so that its students lack the physical fitness programs that most  
18 other students enjoy;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature respectfully requests  
20 the Bureau of Indian Affairs to establish a four-year high school at  
21 Unalakleet.

26 Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators and the Honorable  
27 Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in
