2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 61

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Requesting the Congress to appropriate
6 funds for harbor facilities at King
7 Cove, Alaska.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS fishing is a year-round industry in King Cove, Alaska; and

10 WHEREAS there are about 50 boats moored throughout the year at King
11 Cove with substantial increase of fishing boats during the summer months; and

12 WHEREAS the location of King Cove makes the cove susceptible to severe
13 damage from storms; and

14 WHEREAS, after many years of effort by the state and community, the
15 Congress has authorized construction of harbor facilities at King Cove, but
16 the necessary funds have not been appropriated;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska State Legislature respectfully re-
18 quests the Congress to provide the funds necessary for the Corps of Engineers
19 to construct the authorized harbor facilities at King Cove, Alaska.

27 Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the Honorable
28 Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska delegation
29 in Congress.
