5 Recommending Joseph E. Crusey for  
6 ambassadorship to Iceland.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Joseph E. Crusey's name has been submitted to the president  
9 for appointment as the United States Ambassador to Iceland; and

10 WHEREAS Mr. Crusey is a patriotic citizen of the highest moral and  
11 ethical character and a student of Alaska's historical heritage with an  
12 avid interest in the economic and social growth of the State of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS Alaska and Iceland have much in common in their respective  
14 environments thus imminently qualifying Mr. Crusey for this ambassadorship  
15 since mutual understanding of the problems of the country of Iceland and  
16 the State of Alaska would be incalculably beneficial to both the United  
17 States and Iceland;

18 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth State Legislature endorses Mr. Crusey  
19 and urges the President of the United States to give favorable consideration  
20 for his appointment as ambassador to Iceland.
