BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS quality education is one of the primary concerns of state and
9 federal government and is the key to an enlightened and progressive society;

WHEREAS the high cost of living in rural Alaska continues to rise even
12 higher each year; and

WHEREAS in order to attract and retain well-qualified personnel in the
14 rural schools, the salaries of teachers must at least keep pace with the
15 rising cost of living;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Legislature of the State of Alaska re-
17 quests the Bureau of Indian Affairs to raise the rating of personnel in the
18 BIA schools to the following levels:

Starting Teacher -- GS 10

Bachelor's Degree - GS 12

Master's Degree -- GS 14

Teacher's Aid -- GS 7
