2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 87

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Urging the adoption of youth stand-by
6 fares by all airlines in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the existence of a youth stand-by fare often spells the differ-
9 ence between a student spending the holidays with his loved ones or away from
10 home in a nearly empty dormitory; and

11 WHEREAS existing programs for youth stand-by fares have proven to not
12 only benefit the student seeking inexpensive travel home but also the air-
13 lines which have them; and

14 WHEREAS the existence of youth stand-by fares on all the scheduled air-
15 line routes would serve to benefit the students who need them the most by
16 providing inexpensive travel to outlying communities;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the adoption of
18 youth stand-by fares by all scheduled airlines in Alaska and requests that
19 favorable consideration be given all applications for these fares to the
20 Civil Aeronautics Board.

21 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Secor D. Brown,
22 Chairman of the Civil Aeronautics Board, and to all scheduled airlines
23 operating in or through Alaska.
