2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 89

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting the construction of a new  
6 school for St. Paul Island, Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS, under the terms of the fur seal treaty of 1966, it is provided  
9 that the educational needs of the Natives of St. Paul Island shall be met  
10 in the same manner as all other citizens of the State of Alaska, including  
11 the furnishing of necessary educational facilities; and

12 WHEREAS the only school at St. Paul Island is a deteriorating frame  
13 constructed building built 40 years ago that is a serious fire hazard; and

14 WHEREAS the school presently has an enrollment of approximately 150  
15 students, and is generally inadequate for modern day educational needs;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska State Legislature respectfully  
17 requests the Department of the Interior to construct a new school at  
18 St. Paul Island, Alaska.

24 the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska  
25 delegation in Congress.
