2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 91

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution  
6 of the State of Alaska to provide for  
7 special sessions of the legislature to be  
8 called by the president of the senate and  
9 the speaker of the house.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. Sec. 9, Art. II of the Constitution of the State of Alaska  
12 is amended to read:

13 SECTION 9. SPECIAL SESSIONS. Special sessions may be called by  
14 the governor, by the speaker of the house and the president of the  
15 senate concurring or by vote of two-thirds of the legislators. The vote  
16 may be conducted by the legislative council or as prescribed by law.  
17 At special sessions called by the governor, legislation shall be  
18 limited to subjects designated in his proclamation calling the session  
19 or to subjects presented by him. Special sessions are limited to  
20 thirty days.

21 \* Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this Resolution shall be placed be-  
22 fore the voters of the state at the next statewide election in conformity  
23 with Sec. 1, Art. XIII of the Constitution of the State of Alaska and the  
24 state election laws.
