4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to student fares on the  
6 Alaska Railroad.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS students usually do not have the funds necessary to travel  
9 throughout the state; and

10 WHEREAS, as a part of their education, students should be encouraged  
11 to travel in order to see and understand Alaska; and

12 WHEREAS the Alaska Railroad is often traveling with far less than a  
13 capacity load; and

14 WHEREAS, if students were allowed to travel on the Alaska Railroad at  
15 a special fare when space is available, both the students and the state  
16 would benefit;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Sixth Alaska Legislature respectfully requests  
18 the Department of Transportation to reduce student fares on the Alaska Rail-  
19 road to a special fare when space is available.
