3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Commending the City of Yellowknife,
6 Northwest Territories, Canadian host
7 of the Arctic Winter Games.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the picturesque capital city of the Northwest Territories --
10 Yellowknife -- has graciously furnished the site for the first Arctic Winter
11 Games; and

12 WHEREAS the Arctic Winter Games afford an historic opportunity for
13 amateur athletes from the Northwest Territories, the Yukon and Alaska to
14 compete in a full range of sports events; and

15 WHEREAS the Arctic Winter Games also afford an excellent opportunity
16 for cultural exchange, between competing athletes and spectators alike; and

17 WHEREAS Alaska has sent a delegation of some 250 members to the
18 Winter Games; and

19 WHEREAS the members of the Alaska delegation have been warmly and
20 enthusiastically received by Canadian officials, including the Prime Minister,
21 Pierre Trudeau, city fathers and especially by the fine people of Yellowknife;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the State of Alaska heartily
23 commends the officials and citizens of Yellowknife, Northwest Territories,
24 for serving as such fine hosts for what is hoped to be the first of many
25 Arctic Winter Games; and be it

26 FURTHER RESOLVED that special good wishes go to the citizens of the
27 Northwest Territories in this their centennial year as a territory.

28 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Pierre Trudeau,
29 Prime Minister of Canada; the Honorable Stuart M. Hodgson, Commissioner

1 of the Northwest Territories; to the Council of the Northwest Territories
2 and the Mayor and Council of Yellowknife.
