2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 118

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Encouraging the Farmers Home Adminis-
6 tration to continue to provide low-
7 cost housing in rural Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS one of the most pressing problems in Alaska today is the lack
10 of adequate rural housing; and

11 WHEREAS it is recognized that some 8,000 housing units must be built
12 or replaced annually in Alaska over the next five years; and

13 WHEREAS future housing construction needs cannot be met unless the
14 state takes immediate steps to provide incentives and assistance to all
15 segments of the home building industry in Alaska; and

16 WHEREAS in the area of rural housing the Federal Farmers Home Adminis-
17 tration could provide an extremely valuable service to the people of Alaska
18 by making more loans; and

19 WHEREAS, because of the overwhelming need for low-cost housing in the
20 state, the Farmers Home Administration should be encouraged to take a greater
21 part in the future to provide housing funds and programs in the state;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Farmers Home Administration is respectfully re-
23 quested to not only continue but to increase its activities in the field of
24 providing low-cost housing in rural Alaska.

26 Administrator, Farmers Home Administration; the Honorable Louis D. Malotky,
27 Director of Rural Housing Loan Division, Farmers Home Administration; and to

29 the Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska
