2 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 121

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 SIXTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to unfair competition by sub-  
6 sidized air carriers and urging an  
7 investigation by the Civil Aeronautics  
8 Board.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS subsidized air carriers are presently competing with nonsubsidi-  
11 zed intrastate air carriers in intrastate operations; and

12 WHEREAS undercutting competition between a subsidized air carrier and  
13 a nonsubsidized air carrier cannot help but lead to the demise of the non-  
14 subsidized carrier; and

15 WHEREAS this type of competition is, on the surface, a violation of  
16 laws and regulations relating to subsidized air carriers;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature urges the Civil Aero-  
18 nautics Board to investigate the present apparent use of subsidies by air  
19 carriers entering into direct competition with nonsubsidized Alaska air  
20 carriers.

25 Chairman of the House Interstate and Foreign Commerce Committee; and to the  
26 Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U. S. Senators, and the  
27 Honorable Howard W. Pollock, U. S. Representative, members of the Alaska  
28 delegation in Congress.
