5 Relating to the electric voting machine.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

7 WHEREAS there have been occasions during the current legislative session
8 when members have been confused due to the practice of some legislators
9 flipping the voting switch from one position to another; and

10 WHEREAS in any event it is undesirable for any member of the legislature
11 to see how a colleague votes on any given issue before he himself votes;

12 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests
13 the Legislative Council to direct the executive director of the Legislative
14 Affairs Agency to have the appropriate wiring changes made so that the
15 lights of the voting machine will not be activated until such time as the
16 Speaker asks the body "Has any member failed to vote?"
