11 WHEREAS Secretary of the Interior Walter J. Hickel, in a recent letter
12 to President Nixon, demonstrated rare insight into some of the grave problems
13 which face our nation today; and

14 WHEREAS in a time of increased dissatisfaction with America's course
15 in world and national affairs and the resulting polarization of and dissen-
16 sion between groups of American citizens, Secretary Hickel's call to the
17 administration for moderation, deeper understanding and better communications
18 was indeed refreshing and uplifting; and

19 WHEREAS Walter J. Hickel has himself answered a deep-seated mood of the
20 American people by courageously and in a statesmanlike manner pointing out
21 to President Nixon the means to truly "bring us together";

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska House of Representatives hereby commends
23 and congratulates Secretary of the Interior Walter J. Hickel for his
24 courageous stand on behalf of the young people of the United States and
25 against their further alienation from the viable democratic processes.
