Relating to the False Pass fishery.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS this season's salmon run in Bristol Bay is predicted to be one
8 of the largest in 30 years; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of this fact, the Legislature has provided for
10 a Fish and Game enforcement vessel in the area; and

11

WHEREAS the False Pass fishery has been in existence for 60 years; and

12

WHEREAS it was not the intent of the Legislature that action be taken
13 through SCR 34 other than to provide protection and accumulate data to deter-
14 mine if the False Pass fishery is in fact expanding and posing any problems
15 during weak runs; and

16

WHEREAS the False Pass fishery has become mainly a local resident
17 fishery in the last few years;

18

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fish and Game is respectfully requested
19 not to take any action restricting fishing in the False Pass fishery and not
20 to change any of the regulations relating to that fishery during the 1970
21 fishing season.
