5 Relating to state occupancy of BIA-
6 owned education facilities at Mount
7 Edgecumbe, Alaska.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

9 WHEREAS there is a need for a regional vocational-technical post
10 secondary-adult school in Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS the local public high schools could utilize the facilities of
12 such a school to a significant degree; and

13 WHEREAS there are certain existing facilities that could be adapted
14 for use as a regional vocational-technical post secondary-adult school; and

15 WHEREAS the BIA is planning construction of a dormitory for the 200
16 students who will be attending the Sitka Public High School, thus creating a
17 vacancy in the facilities at Mount Edgecumbe; and

18 WHEREAS the state will fund the construction of classrooms for the
19 Sitka Borough to house the 200 students;

20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the Governor is
21 respectfully requested to direct the State Departments of Education and
22 Public Works to investigate the feasibility of assuming the operational
23 responsibility of the BIA-Mount Edgecumbe Schools with the intention of
24 maintaining a regional vocational-technical post secondary and adult training
25 school for selected senior high school students, post secondary, and adult
26 citizens of the State of Alaska.
