6 For an Act entitled: "An Act increasing the average daily membership allot-  
7 ment in the public school foundation program; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.060(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The average daily membership allotment for each district is  
12 as follows:

13 (1) if the district is in the Southeastern Senate District:  
14 \$170 [\$155] times average daily membership;

15 (2) if the district is in the Southcentral Senate District:  
16 \$180 [\$165] times average daily membership;

17 (3) if the district is in the Central and Northwest Senate  
18 Districts and that part of the Southcentral Senate District lying west  
19 of 152° west longitude: \$190 [\$175] times the average daily  
20 attendance.

21 \* Sec. 2. The provisions of this Act are retroactive to January 1, 1968.

22 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and ap-  
23 proval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
