6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to legal holidays; and providing for
7 an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal
11 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the
12 twelfth of February, known as Lincoln's birthday; (3) the third Monday
13 in [TWENTY-SECOND OF] February, known as Washington's birthday; (4) the
14 thirtieth of March, known as Seward's Day; (5) the last Monday in
15 [THIRTIETH OF] May, known as Memorial Day or Decoration Day; (6) the
16 fourth of July, known as Independence Day; (7) the first Monday in
17 September, known as Labor Day; (8) the eighteenth of October, known as
18 Alaska Day; (9) the fourth Monday in October [ELEVENTH OF NOVEMBER],
19 known as Veterans' Day; (10) the twenty-fifth of December; (11) every
20 Sunday; (12) every day designated by public proclamation by the Presi-
21 dent of the United States or the governor of the state as a legal
22 holiday or as a day of Thanksgiving.

23 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 1970.
