6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to a new superior court judge; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court consists  
11 of 12 [11] judges, two of whom shall be judges in the first judicial  
12 district, one of whom shall be judge in the second judicial district,  
13 seven[SIX] of whom shall be judges in the third judicial district, and  
14 two of whom shall be judges in the fourth judicial district. At the  
15 time of submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill a  
16 vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council shall also  
17 designate the district in which the appointee is to reside and serve.

18 \* Sec. 2. The judicial position created by this Act shall be assigned to  
19 the City of Kenai.

20 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
