6 For an Act entitled: "An Act eliminating the required local tax effort  
7 under the public school foundation program; and pro-  
8 viding for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.17.030(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) the required local effort of each district is [THE SUM OF  
12 THE REQUIRED LOCAL TAX EFFORT OF THE DISTRICT AND] one-half of Public  
13 Law 874 money received from the federal government in the pre-fiscal  
14 year.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.17.130(b) is amended to read:

16 (b) The district shall estimate the amount of Public Law 874  
17 money it will receive in the pre-fiscal year, and one-half of the  
18 estimate of money to be received shall be the [INCLUDED IN THE TOTAL  
19 SUM OF] required local effort as provided by sec. 30(a) of this  
20 chapter. This figure shall be adjusted at a later time but before  
21 final accounting for the fiscal year to reflect one-half of the  
22 Public Law 874 money actually paid or credited to the district during  
23 the pre-fiscal year.

24 \* Sec. 3. AS 14.17.149 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 14.17.140. DETERMINATION OF FULL AND TRUE VALUE BY LOCAL  
26 AFFAIRS AGENCY. To determine supplemental allocations authorized by  
27 sec. 75 of this chapter, the [THE] Local Affairs Agency, in consulta-  
28 tion with the assessor for each district, shall determine the full  
29 value of the taxable real and personal property in each district.

1 Exemptions granted under Chapter 129, SLA 1957, known as the Alaska In-  
2 dustrial Incentive Act (AS43.25), shall be honored. If there is no  
3 local assessor or current local assessment for a district, then the  
4 Local Affairs Agency shall make the determination of full value from  
5 information available. In making the determination, the Local Affairs  
6 Agency shall be guided by AS 29.10.396. The determination of full  
7 value shall be made before September 16 and sent by registered mail be-  
8 fore that date to the president of the school board in each district.  
9 Duplicate copies shall be sent to the commissioner. The district may  
10 obtain judicial review of the determination by filing a motion in the  
11 superior court of the judicial district in which the district is located  
12 within 10 days after receipt of the determination. The superior court  
13 may modify the determination of the Local Affairs Agency only upon a  
14 finding of abuse of discretion or upon a finding that there is no sub-  
15 stantial evidence to support the determination.

16 \* Sec. 4. The following laws are repealed: AS 14.17.030(b) - (c);  
17 and AS 14.17.130(a).
